

## 2026-2027 ACHE Regent’s Award Nomination Form - Northern and Central California



### ACHE Regent’s Awards Criteria:

- Nominees who are highly engaged and visible with the local chapter or national organization (volunteering, speaking, etc.) will be given strong preference for recognition within an award category.
- **Early Careerist Award:** (1) A current member of ACHE residing within the Regent’s Northern and Central California geography (i.e. 50 of California’s 58 counties, as far South as Kern County and San Luis Obispo and North to the Oregon border), (2) Nominee must clearly demonstrate they have worked and contributed within this geography for at least 12 months before the application deadline AND (3) 5 or less years of formal leadership experience (supervisor, managers, project manager, etc.)
- **Emerging Executive Award:** (1) A current member of ACHE residing within the Regent’s Northern and Central California geography (i.e. 50 of California’s 58 counties, as far South as Kern County and San Luis Obispo and North to the Oregon border), (2) Nominee must clearly demonstrate they have worked and contributed within this geography for at least 12 months before the application deadline AND (3) 6 or more years of formal leadership experience
- **Senior Executive Award:** (1) A current Fellow member of ACHE residing within the Regent, Northern and Central California geography, (2) a CEO, COO, or other senior-level executive title within the organization AND (3) Nominee must have worked and contributed within this geography for at least 12 months before the application deadline.

The nomination deadline is **11:59 PM PST on June 30, 2026**. All nominations are required to be submitted directly to [NS.ACHEregent@gmail.com](mailto:NS.ACHEregent@gmail.com) and must be complete to be considered for the award. A nomination will be considered complete only if it includes two documents: (1) a recent resume or CV and (2) this completed nomination form with all sections completed to articulate how the nominee meets or exceeds the criteria set forth. **Please attach additional pages as necessary.** Award recipients will be determined by the Regent's Advisory Council (RAC).
